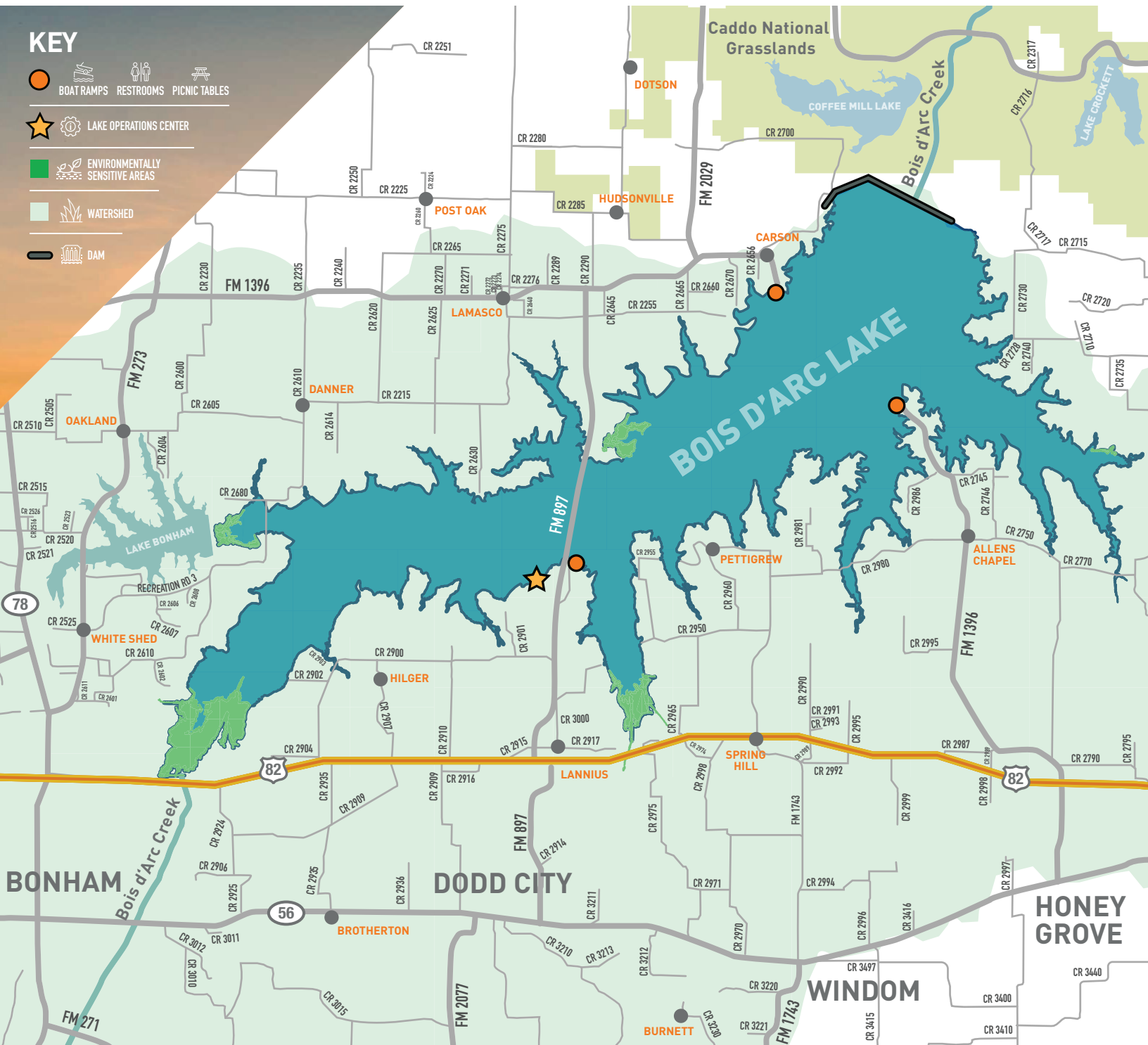
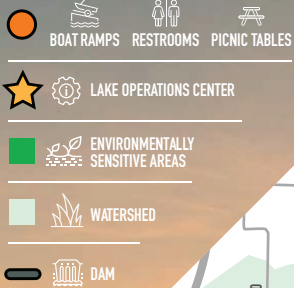

FAST FACTS ABOUT BOIS D'ARC LAKE

- Pronounced bo-dar'k and named after the Bois d'Arc tree, a distinctive symbol for its special significance in the region and a way to honor local history.
- Open to boating, fishing and other water recreation — stocked with selectively bred largemouth bass and channel catfish.
- Three public access areas, each with parking lots, boat ramps, public restrooms and picnic tables (see map above).
- 172 miles of shoreline.
- Lake surface area equal to 26 square miles.
- Average depth of 22 ft. and maximum depth of 70 ft.
- Annual reliable water supply of 82 million gallons of water per day.*

*Annual reliable supply is the amount of water that can be supplied to cover water needs even during the driest conditions we have ever experienced.
